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# Course background & History

# FINDING /OUTCOME

# Kesimpulan

- ❑ Kekurangan dari segi pengumpulan data yang berasaskan kepada Gender indicator. Di Malaysia walaupun terdapat data yang berasaskan jantina dikumpul dan dijana secara tahunan, ini disumbangkan oleh badan-badan R&D yang melakukan secara sukarela. Laporan tersebut tidak akan merangkumi keseluruhan data yang sebenarnya.
- ❑ Rata-rata wanita di kawasan pedalaman negara ASEAN mengalami fenomena yang agak sama terutamanya agak ketinggalan dalam pendidikan, sosioekonomi dan kerjaya. Walaupun Malaysia merupakan negara yang agak kehadapan masih ada lagi dalam peratusan yang kecil yang perlu diberi keutamaan dan ditangani.
